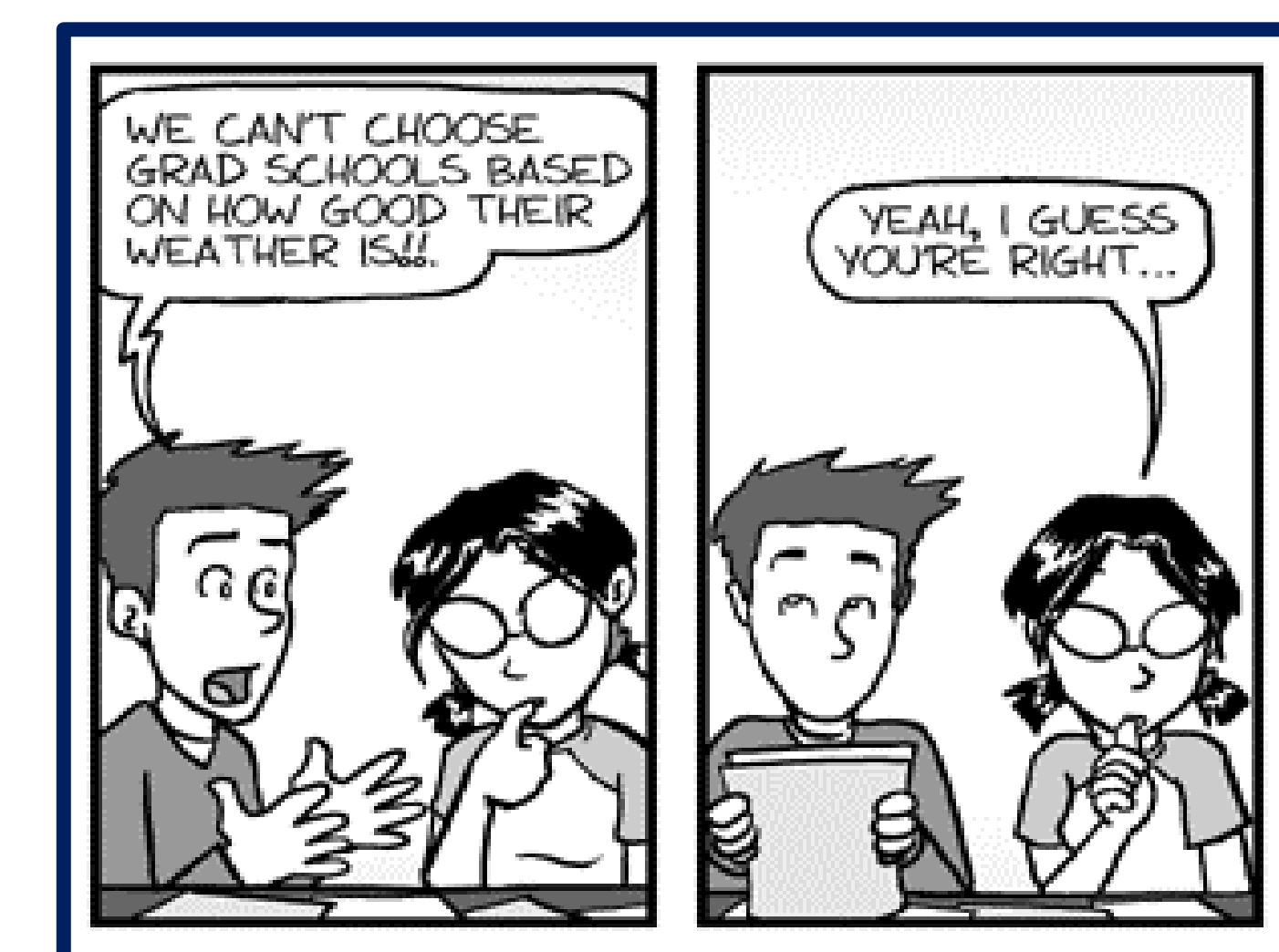

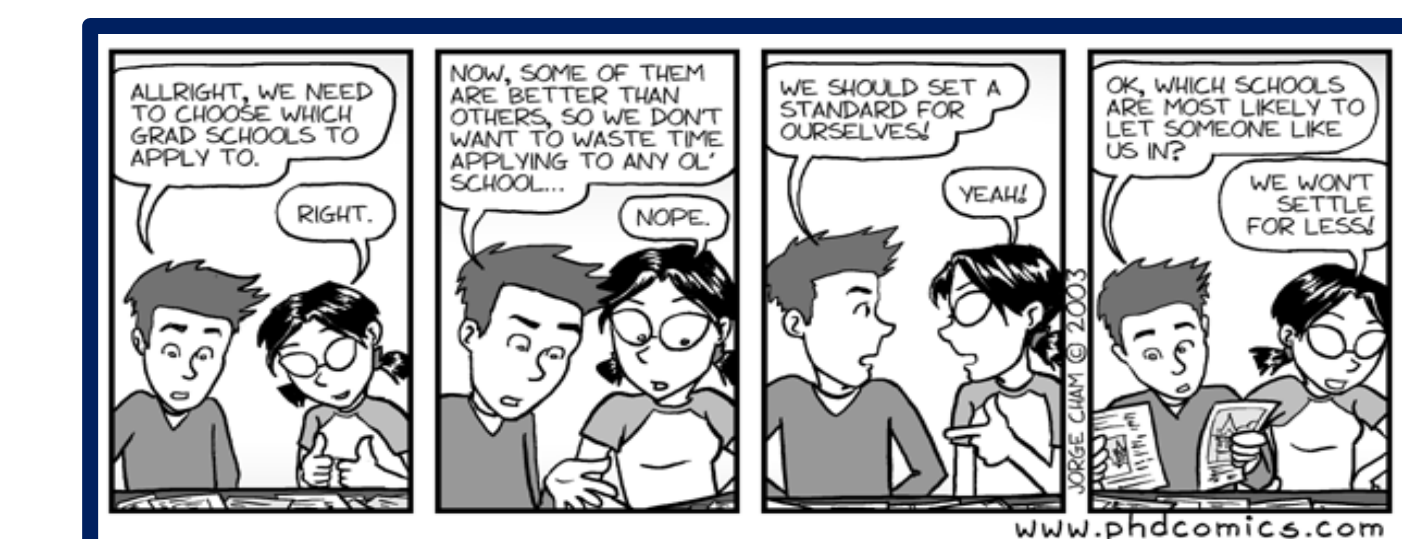

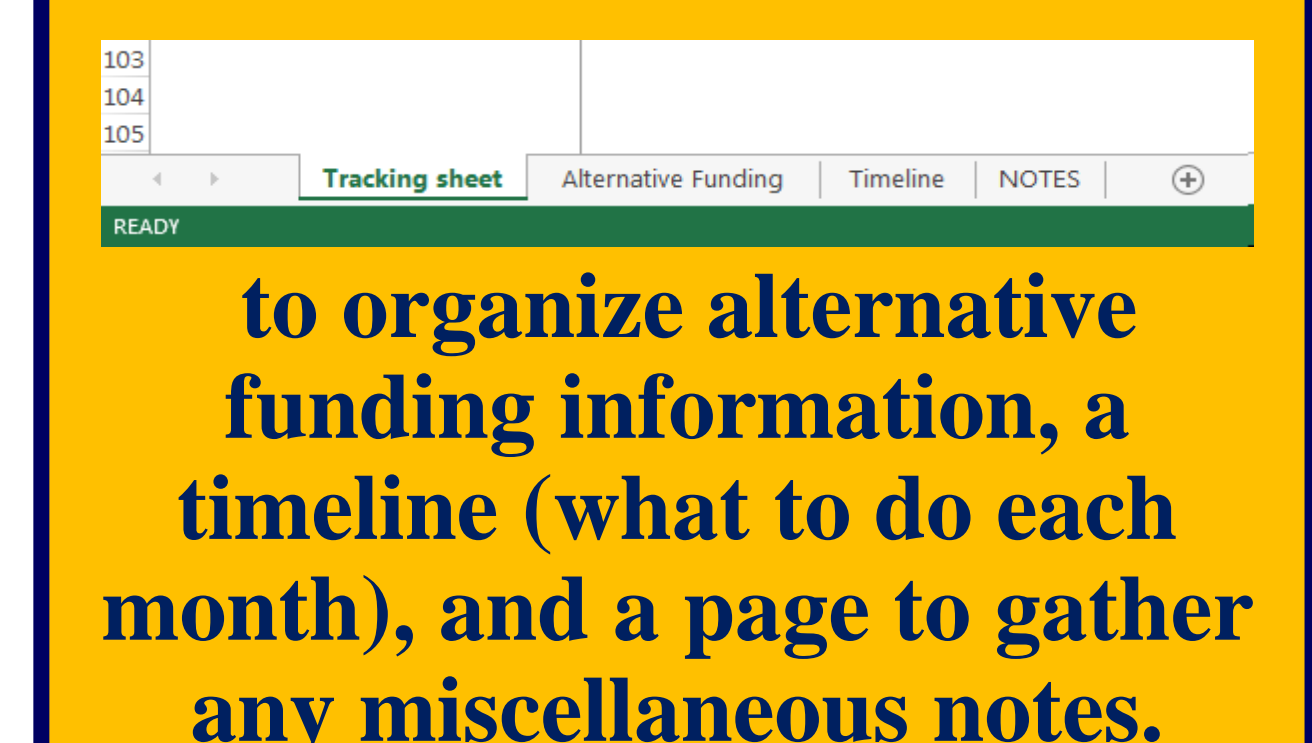
The first column is frozen, which allows students to move the college they're working on close to the row headings
